2. ELIGIBILITY

EDUCATION QUALIFICATION	SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS
Passed 10+2 or Equivalent examination in stream /subjects approved by Central/State Boards of Education	(i) Individual should have represented the country in Junior International meets in any of the above mentioned sports discipline. The current achievement would be given preference during selection trials.
	(ii) Individual should have attained the standard of fifth place in the Junior National Championship or Inter University Championship in above mentioned sports discipline. The current achievement would be given preference during selection trials.
	(iii) In team events, the individual should have represented state in Junior National Championship and National School Tournament conducted by School Games Federation of India (SGFI) in above mentioned sports discipline. The current achievement would be given preference during selection trials.

Note: Candidates represented International/National level and achieved position but not possessing 10+2 educational qualification may also apply. However, candidature of such candidates will be subject to verification of sports credentials & performance during selection trials. Relaxation of educational qualification (**Not Below Matric**) will be considered on case to case basis for eligible candidates.

3. **Date of Birth Block:** Candidates should be born between **01 Jul 1995 to 28 Jun 1999** (both days inclusive). Upper age limit of date of enrolment is 21 years.

Note: Age relaxation (not below 16 years and not exceeding 25 years of age) would be considered in exceptional cases on case to case basis, based on the level of achievement in National/International sports events.

4. **Secretary, Air Force Sports Control Board** reserves the right to shortlist the applications on the basis of the available vacancies.

5. **Medical Standards:** (a) **Height:** Minimum acceptable height: **152.5 cm.** (b) **Chest:** Minimum range of expansion: **5 cm.** (c) **Weight:** Proportionate to height and age. (d) **Vision:** Minimum visual standard: Unaided **6/36**, corrected to at least **6/9** for each eye with spectacles, Dioptric power not exceeding ± 3.5 Dioptres in any axis. Full field of vision and Defective safe colour vision CP-II/III. **(Candidates should bring latest prescription and spectacles for corrected vision, if used).** (e) **Corneal Surgery** (PRK/LASIK) is not acceptable. (f) **Hearing:** Candidates should have normal hearing i.e., able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 meters with each ear separately. (g) **Dental:** Should have healthy gums, good set of teeth and minimum 14 dental points. (h) **Health:** Candidates should be free from Medical or Surgical deformity. He should be free from all communicable diseases and skin ailments. Candidates must be physically and mentally **FIT** to perform duty in any part of the world, in any climate and terrain. The candidates are advised to get wax removed from their ears and tartar and stains removed from their teeth before appearing for selection trials.

Note: Candidate should bring latest prescription and spectacles for corrected vision, if used. The prescription must bear the signature, stamp and registration number of Eye specialist. Candidates are advised to get tartar and stain removed from teeth, Ears should be free of wax. Permanent body tattoos on inner face of the fore arms (inside of elbow to the wrist), Black (dorsal) part of the hand/reverse side of palm and Tribals with tattoos which are as per custom and traditions of their tribes only are permitted. Candidate with permanent body tattoos are to submit a photograph of the tattoo with details of size and type of the tattoo.

6. Candidate discharged from the Indian Air Force/Indian Navy/Indian Army or dismissed from any Government Organisation for any reason earlier is **NOT TO APPLY.**

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

7. **Training & Tenure:** Enrolment is for an initial period of 20 years extendable up to the age of 57 years. Initially candidates will be sent for a Joint Basic Phase Training (JBPT) at Basic training Institute, Belgaum (Karnataka). On successful completion of JBPT, candidates will be allocated trades and sent for trade training of specified duration. Training is however liable to be terminated at any time if the trainee fails to achieve the required standards in academics, profession, physical fitness and discipline or is found to be medically unfit.

8. **Pay & Allowances:** During training, a stipend of **Rs. 11,400/- per month** will be paid. On completion of training, starting gross emoluments at the minimum of scale of pay including Dearness Allowances (DA) will be **20,500/- per month** (Approximately) and, which, in subsequent year, may rise upto **Rs. 38,720/- per month** (approximately) depending upon the rank attained. Other allowances such as Transport allowance, Composite Personnel Maintenance allowance (CPMA), Leave Ration allowance (LRA), Fly/PJI allowance (If applicable), Family Planning allowance (If applicable), HRA etc are also admissible to airmen **(Revision of Pay & Allowances under consideration by Govt of India according to the recommendation of 7th Pay Commission).**

9. Perquisites. Perks such as Ration, Clothing, Medical facilities, Accommodation, CSD (Canteen), facilities, Leave (60 days Annual and 30 days casual in a calendar year as a privilege), Education concession to children, Recreational facilities, Free transport to school going children and Leave Travel Concession (LTC) are also provided as per existing rules. Note withstanding the above; Group Insurance cover of Rs. 25,00,000/- at premium of Rs. 1730/- per month is covered for all airmen and facility of Group Housing Scheme is also extended. Other facilities by Air Force Wives Welfare Association (AFWWA) are also extended to family of airmen.

- 10. **Promotion:** Promotion prospects exist up to the rank of Master Warrant Officer (MWO). Opportunities to become Commissioned Officer also exist for those airmen who qualify the prescribed examination, later during their service career.
- 11. **Post Retirement Benefits.** Pension, Gratuity, Leave Encashment, Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) and CSD (Canteen) facilities comprise some of the post retirement benefits. Specialised Pre-release Course (PRC) are also arranged to enable airmen to take up post retirement career. In addition, airmen also get relaxation in age and reservation in Govt. Services as ex-servicemen.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- 12. **Selection Trials:** Eligible candidates will be sent call letters for selection trials. The date and venue will be mentioned in call letter.
- 13. Selection trials will be conducted in following phases:-
 - (a) **Physical Fitness Test (PFT):** PFT consists of a 1.6 Km run to be completed within 8 minutes. Candidates completing the PFT in less than 7 minutes 30 seconds will be awarded additional marks on a sliding scale. Candidates are advised to bring their sports kit/playing kit/sports shoes and shorts.
 - (b) Only PFT pass candidates would be called for sports skill trials.
 - (c) Candidates who qualify in PFT and selection trials for the game applied will be called for interview.
 - (d) Those who are recommended will appear in Medical Examination conducted by Air Force Medical Team as per IAF medical standards.

GENERAL

- 14. (a) **The decision of selection committee/Air Force Sports Control Board in all matters relating to eligibility acceptance or rejection of application etc will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry or correspondence will be entertained in this regard.**
- (b) Candidates must appear in the selection trials at New Delhi.
- (c) **REQUESTS FOR CHANGE OF VENUE FOR SELECTION TRIALS OR DATE OF SELECTION TRIAL WILL NOT BE ENTERTAINED.**
- (d) However in case of non availability of sports infrastructure of a particular sports in Delhi. AFSCB reserve the right to hold trials outside Delhi. Intimation/call letters would be sent accordingly.
- (e) Candidates not reporting for the trial on due date and time will not be accommodated on other dates/shifts.
- (f) **Incomplete application will be rejected.**
- (g) Candidates should be prepared to stay for the entire duration of the selection trials and medical examination in Delhi/place mentioned in call letter for which they have to make their own arrangement. No TA/DA will be admissible.
- (h) Candidates who are less than 18 years of age on the date of trial should get the consent form, duly signed their parents/guardian while coming for the selection trial. (The format of the consent form is given in the application format).
- (j) **Para 6 of the application format, if applicable, is to be filled with Red Ink.**

HOW TO APPLY

15. **Application Form: APPLICATION SHOULD BE ON A4 SIZE PAPER ONLY IN THE PRESCRIBED FORMAT** Non-standard application forms will be rejected. The following are to be sent along with the application:-

(a) Three copies of unattested recent (**not older than three months**) passport size **COLOUR PHOTOGRAPH** (front portrait without headgear except for Sikhs), **ONE** of which is to be pasted on the application form and the **other two** are to be **stapled** to the top left corner of the application form. **THE PHOTOGRAPH IS TO BE TAKEN WITH CANDIDATE HOLDING A BLACK SLATE IN FRONT OF HIS CHEST WITH HIS NAME, DATE OF BIRTH AND DATE OF PHOTOGRAPH CLEARLY WRITTEN ON IT WITH WHITE CHALK IN CAPITAL LETTERS.** Photographs should be only on good quality "Photo Paper."

(b) Attested copies of Matriculation Certificate in support of Date of Birth. Attested copies of Marks Sheet & Certificate of Education Qualification along with attested copies of Sports achievement certificates.

(c) One **unstamped self addressed 24cm x 10 cm WHITE ENVELOPE of good quality**, stapled/pinned with the application form.

16. **Candidates are to bring with them the following at the time of selection trail:-**

(a) Four copies of photographs (same as submitted with the application).

(b) Original Matriculation passing certificate with four attested photo copies for verification of date of birth.

(c) Original Matriculation mark sheet with four attested copies.

(d) Original passing certificate and mark sheet of Intermediate/10 +2 with four attested photo copies.

(e) Original certificates regarding sports achievement with four attested photo copies.

(f) Character Certificate.

(g) Sports Kit.
