b) SECOND PHASE :-

All the candidates appearing in this stage must have to qualify the PST/PET and documentation for further appearing in the next stage (2nd written test i.e. descriptive test).

- a) FOR HC (RO):- Candidates must qualify descriptive test as well as dictation test during this stage.
- b) FOR HC (RM):- Candidates must have to qualify descriptive test during this stage.

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Note: - Procedure for drawl of merit in case of tie

- i) Candidates who scores more marks in total will be placed higher in merit.
- ii) If marks are equal then candidates who scores more marks in screening test (OMR based) will be placed higher in merit.
- iii) If in all conditions as mentioned in sub para (i) & (ii) above, the position is still same then preference will be given to the candidates older in age.
- iv) In all conditions as mentioned in sub para (i), (ii) & (iii) above, the position is still same, the preference will be given alphabetically.
- v) If any candidate of reserved category finds place in merit without availing any relaxation, he/she will be placed in merit against the UR category.

(ii) HC (RM)

Matriculation or equivalent from a recognized Board and two years Industrial Training Institute Certificate (ITI) in Radio and Television or, General Electronics or, computer operator & Programming Assistant or, Data Preparation & Computer Software or, Electrician or, Fitter or, Info Technology & Electronics System maintenance or, Computer Hardware or, Network Technician or, Mechatronics or, Data Entry Operator from a recognized Institute.

Or

Pass in Intermediate or 12^{th} standard or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics from a recognized Board or University or Institution as a regular student with aggregate 60% marks in PCM subject.

(B) AGE LIMIT:-

- Not below 18 years or over 25 years as on 12/06/2019 (closing date) for General Category.
- ii) Not below 18 years or over 28 years <u>as on 12/06/2019 (closing date)</u> for OBC Category.
- iii) Not below 18 years or over 30 years as on 12/06/2019 (closing date) for SC & ST Category.

Note 1.- The minimum height of Male candidates falling in category of Garhwalies, Kumaonese, Gorkhas, Dogras, Marathas and candidates belonging to the states of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Kashmir and Leh and Ladakh regions of J&K will be 165 Cms. 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(D) MEDICAL STANDARDS (For Male/Female):

- (i) Minimum distant vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 of the both eyes without correction i.e. without wearing glasses.
- (ii) Must pass high-grade colour vision test.
- (iii) Must not have knock-knees, flat feet or varicose vein or squint in eyes and they should possess CP-III BY ISIHARA.
- (iv) Must be in sound mental and bodily health and free from any defect/deformity likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

5. EWS (Economically Weaker Section) Reservation:

- a) Candidates who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SC/ST/OBC and whose family gross annual income is below Rs. 8 Lakh (Rupees Eight Lakh) shall be eligible for benefit of reservation for EWS. The income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application. Also candidates whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, in espective of family income:
 - i. 5 Acres of agriculture land and above.
 - ii. Residential flat of 1000 Sq Ft and above.
 - iii. Residential plot of 100 Sq Yd and above in notified municipalities.

iv. Residential plot of 200 Sq Yd and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.

- b) The property held by a family in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status. (The term *Family* for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation. His/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years).
- c) The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an income and asset certificate issued by a competent authority. The income and asset certificate issued by any one of the following authorities in the prescribed format as given in Annexure-III shall only be accepted as candidate's claim as belonging to EWS: -
 - District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/ Additional Deputy Commissioner/1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/Sub Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner; or,
 - Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate; or,
 - iii. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar; or,
 - iv. Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/or his/her family normally resides.
- d) The candidate applying against the vacancies reserved for EWS must possess Income and asset certificate as on closing date of online application for this advertisement. Accordingly, these candidate are required to produce valid Income and asset certificate during documentation stage. In case of non-compliance of aforesaid stipulations, their claim for reserved status under EWS shall not be entertained and the candidature of such candidates, if fulfilling all the eligibility conditions for General (UR) category, shall be considered under General (UR) vacancies only.

6. **ELIGIBILITY FOR EX-SERVICEMEN:**

- (i) Should have retired from equivalent or higher rank in Army, Navy or Air Force in the same Trade.
 - (ii) Total relaxation in physical standard and educational qualifications.
 - (iii) Age relaxation as mentioned at para 4 (B), Note-II.
 - (iv) Break-in service should not be more than 2 years.
 - (v) Should be in medical category 'SHAPE-1'.

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vi) Other terms and condition for re-employment of ex-servicemen in Ex-Serviceman (Re-employment in Central Civil Service and Posts) Amendment Rules, 2012 and any other instruction issued by GOI from time to time, will also be applicable.

7. FOR COMPASSIONATE APPOINTMENTS

Only wards of deceased/medically board out BSF Personnel, whose application for compassionate appointment forwarded by last unit/HQ served by his/her father and intimated by HQ DG BSF are eligible to apply under this scheme. Candidates eligible under this category will have to produce photocopies of all essential certificates issued from concerned BSF unit/Estt of deceased/invalidated person in addition to other certificates specified in subsequent paras at the time of documentation. Eligibility criteria with proformas of essential documents have already been circulated to all BSF Units/Estt.

8. FOR BSF SERVING PERSONNEL

- (i) Departmental candidate shall be excluded from PST/PET. However, they have to attend 2nd Phase recruitment only for Documentation and descriptive test(s) only.
 - (ii) Should have medical category 'SHAPE-1'.
 - (iii) BSF Serving Constable (GD) and Constable (TM) should be in possession of Disc/Vigilance clearance certificate, Bio-data and NOC issued by their appointing authority and Present Medical Category SHAPE -1 issued by Medical Officer of concerned Units/HQrs prior to closing date of online applications.

9. METHOD OF SELECTION (Tests):

The candidates will have to be appeared in Two written test as under: -

A) FIRST PHASE

WRITTEN EXAMINATION (OMR BASED SCREENING TEST)

For the post of HC (RO) and HC (RM):-

The MCQ type written examination of **03 hours** duration will be conducted at selected centers on the date and time fixed by HQ DG BSF. In the written examination MCQ paper, there will be 100 questions of 200 marks, divided in following four parts: -

NEGATIVE MARKING: - For every multiple-choice question of 2 marks, 0.50 marks will be deducted for every wrong answer.

There will be one OMR based composite paper consisting of above mentioned four parts and the question paper will be **"OMR BASED OBJECTIVE TYPE WITH MULTIPLE CHOICES".** Question paper will be printed both in English as well as Hindi for each post. The minimum qualifying marks of written test for both the posts are as under:-

Direct Entry:-

i) General/OBC - 38 % ii) SC/ST - 33%

However, number of candidates to qualify in OMR Based screening test and further to appear in the next phase shall be restricted to 20 times the number of vacancies for recruitment post.

Note: - Request for re-evaluation of OMR sheets will not be entertained.

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(B) SECOND PHASE -

Shortlisted candidates, successfully qualified in OMR based screening test shall be permitted to appear in next phase i.e. PST/PET and documentation. Intimation through SMS/e-mail shall invariably be sent to all the shortlisted candidates by recruitment centre concerned to attend the Second phase. However, they must also get acquainted themselves for any updates being uploaded on BSF recruitment portal/website time to time.

Note 1:- Physical efficiency test (PET) is a qualifying test. A candidate must qualify in all the three PET/PST events serially as mentioned. Candidates who qualify in race be allowed to appear for the long jump and so on. Candidate who fails in any event will be rejected at that stage only and will not be allowed to appear in the remaining events. Candidate who qualifies the physical test (s), documentation and so on will only be allowed to appear in the Descriptive test. For female candidate, pregnancy at the time of PET will be considered as disqualification and pregnant female candidates shall be rejected at this stage only.

<u>Note 2:-</u> Qualifying the tests does not amount to final selection and the same will be made on the basis of consolidated merit list of all recruitment centers as per the number of vacancies in respective quota.

<u>Note 3:</u>- Admission in recruitment examinations/stages shall be purely on production of call letter / admit card downloaded online by the eligible candidate.

C) THIRD PHASE (DESCRIPTIVE TEST)

Candidates successfully attended PST/PET and documentation stages shall be allowed to appear in next stage i.e. descriptive test. Subsequent dates for appearing in the descriptive test shall be announced to all qualified candidates by FHQ BSF as well as by recruitment centre concerned to attend the descriptive test.

Qualifying marks for the dictation test will be 38% 33% for SC/ST candidates.	for	General/OBC and

Both above descriptive tests will be mandatory and the final merit will be prepared on the marks obtained in these tests.

Evaluation /marking system of dictation test is as under: -

- a) 2.5 Marks will be deducted for each omission/mistake of single letter.
- b) 5 Marks will be deducted for each word mistake/omission.

ii. FOR ASI/RM CANDIDATES:-

A descriptive paper of maximum 200 marks covering Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Logical Reasoning & Electronics subjects (12th standard). **Max time- 3 Hrs** .

D) FOURTH PHASE

Final Medical Examination:-

Candidates who qualify all the above tests will be put through a detailed medical examination to assess their fitness. Medical examination shall be carried out by BSF Medical board of officers.
