		to be engaged by the Medical Consultants. Part-time Medical Consultants will have to make their own arrangements for providing substitute during their absence, at their own cost.	
11	Medicine	To make provision for supply of generic medicines at bank's dispensary with an upper ceiling of Rs. 10000/- per month to ensure uniformity in dispensing of medicines to employees. However any unutilised amount cannot be carried forward for use.	
		Any Practice of purchase of loose medicines from local dealers should be discontinued.	
		To purchase only branded medicines from standard companies. Purchase should be made only through approved suppliers. A panel of approved suppliers duly certified by the Medical Officer should be prepared for each centre.	
		Indents for medicines should be duly certified by Medical officers. The list of drugs should be revised periodically based on the latest changes in the market and duly certified by the Medical officer. Stock Movement Register showing the details of pending stock disbursement etc. should be maintained and duly scrutinized by the Medical Officer.
