Post Title: Research Fellow (Economics)

Requirements: Education:

- **1. Essential**: Master's degree in Economics. Specialization in areas of Public Finance/Public Economics will be preferred.
- 2. Experience: 1–2 years of relevant research experience, preferably in areas of; Public Finance, Public Economics, Macroeconomics, National Income Accounting, Survey Statistics, Fiscal Policy, Budgeting.
- **3. Required**: Hands-on experience of working with statistical software such as R/Stata and document preparation software e.g. LaTeX. Excellent oral and written communication skills in English is a pre-requisite for the position.

Job description: The incumbent will be part of the team of professionals already working on various research projects in the area of health financing, macroeconomic modelling, monitoring key indicators of the economy, taxation, payment systems, expenditure tracking and end use monitoring of public funds and related areas.

The tasks involved include but are not limited to:

- a. Conducting research and providing technical assistance on policy analysis
- b. Collecting, processing, managing and analysing financial and other data from various government agencies
- c. Coordinating with government or other agencies for compilation of data and reports.
- d. Need-based travel to states for collecting data and information and liaising with government officials and other partners
- e. Performing such other duties as may be assigned from time to time

- (c) Convene and lead review meetings related to project deliverables.
- (d) Initiate studies/papers and work with project leaders towards publications
- (e) Need-based travel to states for collecting data and information and liaising with government officials and other partners
