Essential Qualifications:

1) Assistant Professor - Physical Education

A.

- A Master's degree in Physical Education and Sports or Physical Education or Sports Science with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed).
- ii. Record of having represented the University/College at the inter-university/inter-collegiate competitions or the state and/or national championships.
- iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET, or who are or have been awarded a PhD degree in Physical Education or Physical Education and Sports or Sports Science, in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of MPhil/PhD degree) Regulations 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time, as the case may be:

Provided that, candidates registered for PhD degree prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-Laws/Regulations of the institutions

awarding the Degree and such PhD degree holders shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The PhD degree of the candidates has been awarded in regular mode;
- b) The PhD thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) Open PhD viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her PhD work out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers in conference/seminar, based on his/her PhD work.

Note:- The fulfillment of these conditions (a) to (e) is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- v. Passed the physical fitness test conducted in accordance with UGC Regulations 2018.

OR

B. An Asian game or commonwealth games medal winner who has a degree at least at Post-Graduation level.

Physical Fitness Test Norms

- (a) Subject to the provisions of UGC Regulations 2018, all candidates who are required to undertake the physical fitness test are required to produce a medical certificate certifying that he/she is medically fit before undertaking such tests.
- (b) On the production of such certificate mentioned in (a) above, the candidate would be required to undertake the physical fitness test in accordance with the following norms:-

Other conditions:

- 1. The clearing of ICAR/UGC/CSIR NET is mandatory, if conducted
- 2. The clearing of NET / SLET / SET will not be required for candidates possessing a PhD Degree as per UGC Regulations / ICAR / AICTE Guidelines
- 3. Other criteria as per UGC Regulations 2018 would also be applicable
- 4. The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) of UGC Regulations 2018 for Universities shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

General instructions

- 1. A relaxation of 5% marks shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
- 2. A relaxation of 5% marks for the Master's Degree shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree

- prior to 19 September, 1991.
- 3. The time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and / or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/ research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions. Further the period of active service spent on pursuing Research Degree simultaneously with teaching assignment without taking any kind of leave, shall be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment/ promotion.
- 4. Candidates should clearly state the category in which they belong to. They must also enclose attested photocopy of Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority.
- 5. Age limit for applying to the posts shall be as per University Grants Commission / Indian Council for Agriculture Research / All India Council for Technical Education regulations and norms existing or issued from time to time.
- 6. Candidates in service should apply through proper channel or should produce NOC and other requirements as per rules.
- 7. The prescribed essential qualifications are the minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle candidates to be called for interview. Where the number of applications received is large and/or where it will not be convenient or possible to interview all the candidates, the University at its discretion may restrict the number of candidates to a reasonable limit on the basis of qualifications/experience prescribed in the advertisement. Further, the University may also fill up the posts advertised on short-term contract basis, if necessary.
- 8. The University reserves the right to
 - (a) not to fill up any or all posts advertised.
 - (b) draw reserve panels for appointment to possible future vacancies;
- 9. The qualification prescribed shall be as on the last date for receipt of application.
- 10. No interim queries regarding interview/selection will be entertained.
- 11. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
- 12. Interested candidates should apply in duplicate in the <u>prescribed format attached</u> <u>here under</u> along with photocopies of all supporting documents. Both the copies shall be properly bound (in book form).
- 13. All applicants should submit self-assessment Academic Performance Indicator

approved by University, <u>attached here under</u> with all supporting documents.

Without supporting documents, the claim is not accepted.
